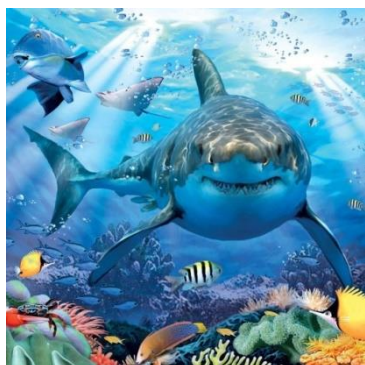

A FEW OTHER REMINDERS

- Please ensure that you collect your child on time as it affects our legal staff ratios. If they are collected late you will be charged £5 per 15 minutes as per your financial agreement.
- Please can you ensure that your child attends in weather appropriate clothing, such as wellies, hats, gloves during wet/cold weather with names in them and sun cream and sun hats labelled and Spare clothes are always useful too!
