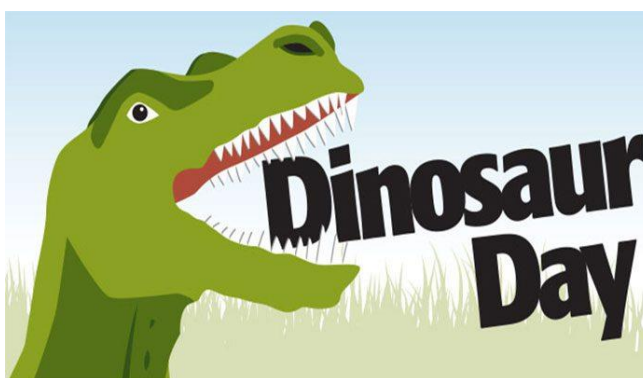


Welcome to our June 2023 Newsletter!

Please can we take this opportunity to remind our parents that our nursery is a **mobile phone free zone**, this means NO taking calls, texting and browsing the internet whilst waiting for your children. This also means that you are unable to show us photos of what your child has been up to, but please feel free to email them to us, we love seeing what they have been up to.



A FEW OTHER REMINDERS

- We have a ring doorbell on the wall to the left of the main door if you could use that and allow time for us to get to the door, alternatively the other door bell is also working.
- Please ensure that you collect your child on time as it effects our legal staff ratios. If they are collected late you will be charged £5 per 15 minutes as per your financial agreement.
- Can we ask that you supply a named sun cream and leave it in your child's bag for us to reapply after lunch.
- Could you also bring in snacks in a labelled container for the day.
- Please can you ensure that your child attends in weather appropriate clothing, such as wellies, hats, gloves during wet/cold weather with names in them. Spare clothes are always useful too!
