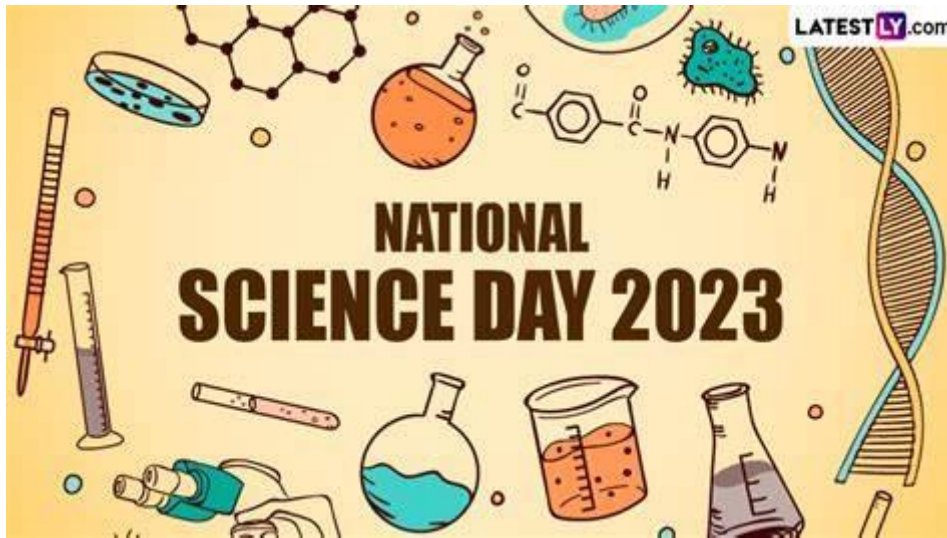

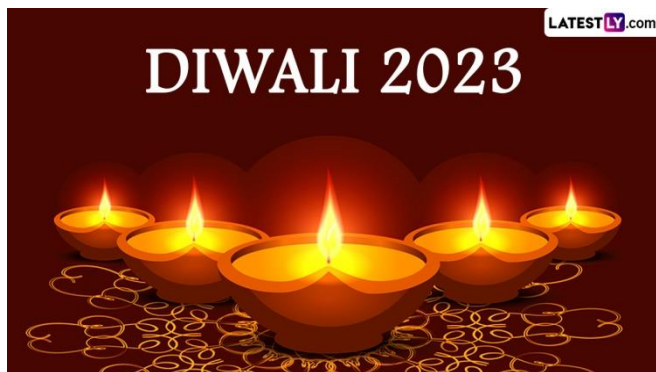
Unfortunately we had to cancel Hadlum Court last week due to the bug going around the Nursery and the poor weather.

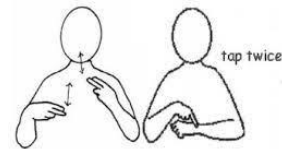
